Who else is attending: Air Force course members, Australian Defence College staff, invited members from the Air Force senior leadership team. (Please note this is a members only night, ie, no partners.)

**Security:** Members will be signed in at the front gate according to the finalised list of nominations. Photo ID (eg, driver's licence) is required. My strongest advice is to obtain a retired members pass, if you don't already have one, to greatly simplify access.
