

Air Chief Marshal (Ret'd) Mark Binskin AC



Air Chief Marshal Binskin served as Chief of the Australian Defence Force from 2014 to 2018, and prior to that, as Vice Chief of the Defence Force, and Chief of Air Force, following his service as Air Commander Australia.

In 2020, he chaired the Royal Commission into National Natural Disaster Arrangements and he is currently Chair of the Civil Aviation Authority and the Pacific Security College.

In April 2024 Air Marshal Binskin was appointed as Special Adviser to the Australian Government on Israel's response to the Israel Defense Forces strikes which killed World Central Kitchen workers. Married to Gitte with two sons, in his free time he engages in his passion for flying, including as the display pilot for the Temora Aviation Museum's Canberra bomber, motor cycling and camping.
